Short-listing Criteria for admission to PG Programmes (2018 – 2019)
Written test/Interview for M.S.(R)/PhD on Wednesday, 05.12.2018

Ph.D. (Full Time / Part Time):

1. Candidates with M. Tech degree:

Category	Minimum Qualification
<u>General</u> and <u>OBC</u>	Minimum of 70 %* Marks or CGPA of 7.0 on a scale of 10 (aggregate of all years) in M.Tech. or equivalent degree.
<u>SC/ST</u> and <u>PH</u>	Minimum of 65 % Marks or CGPA of 6.5 on a scale of 10 (aggregate of all years) in M.Tech. or equivalent degree.

2. Candidates with B.Tech. degree:

Category	Minimum Qualification
<u>General</u> and <u>OBC</u>	Minimum of 75 % Marks or CGPA of 7.5 on a scale of 10 (aggregate of all years) in B.Tech. or equivalent degree and a valid GATE score** for candidates applying for Full Time admission.
<u>SC/ST</u> and <u>PH</u>	Minimum of 70 % Marks or CGPA of 7.0 on a scale of 10 (aggregate of all years) in B.Tech. or equivalent degree and a valid GATE score** for candidates applying for Full Time admission.

*Part-time/sponsored Ph.D. candidates with minimum five years experience may be shortlisted with 65% marks in M.Tech. (CGPA 6.5).

** The following candidates need not appear/qualify in GATE exam:

(i) Currently registered students in Centrally Funded Technical Institutes (CFTIs) pursuing B. Tech./B.E./ Integrated M. Tech/ Integrated M. Sc. programmes, who have completed 6 semesters or more, and have CGPA of 8.00 or above (on a 10 point scale). Such students must obtain a CGPA of 8.00 or above at the time of graduation, and before they formally register for the Ph.D. programme (80% aggregate marks, if marks is the primary mode of evaluation).

(ii) Graduates of CFTIs (in the programmes marked under (i)) with a final graduation CGPA of more than 8.00 (80% aggregate marks, if marks is the primary mode of evaluation).

(iii) M.A or M.Sc. graduates from IITs with CGPA 8.00 or above.

M.S. (Research) {Full Time/Part Time}†

Category	Minimum Qualification
<u>General</u>	GATE score of 700 and Minimum of 67.5 % Marks or CGPA of 6.75 on a scale of 10 (aggregate of all years) in B.Tech. or equivalent degree.
<u>OBC</u>	GATE score of 650 and Minimum of 67.5 % Marks or CGPA of 6.75 on a scale of 10 (aggregate of all years) in B.Tech. or equivalent degree.
<u>SC/ST</u> and <u>PH</u>	GATE score of 450 and Minimum of 62.5 % Marks or CGPA of 6.25 on a scale of 10 (aggregate of all years) in B.Tech. or equivalent degree.

† BTechs from IITs graduating with a CGPA of 8.0 or above need not qualify in GATE exam.

‡ Candidates with a GATE score of 900 and above, or IIT B.Techs. with a graduating CGPA of 8.5 and above, will be given direct admission to the M.S.(R) program, i.e., without the need for entrance exam/interview

Note: Institute criteria for part-time candidates (for both MS(R) and Ph.D. program) as regards experience will be adhered to. Furthermore, they need not qualify in GATE exam.

* Candidates meeting shortlisting criteria are invited for written test/interview even if they do not receive call letter for any reason!
